

Step-by-Step

****Each team must assemble 12 containers (9 Dog: 3 Cat)!****

Pick up supplies and assemble using these instructions:

- 1 Pail (with lid)
- 1 Set of Pail Labels (front, back, and kit type: "Cat Kit" or "Dog Kit")
- 1 Leash
- 1 Collar
- 6 Plastic grocery bags
- 1 Rubber band
- 1 Chew Stick (FOR DOGS ONLY)
- 1 Can of Food
- 1 Bottle of Water
- 1 Bowl
- 1 Glo-stick
- 1 Toy or Ball
- 1 Towel/Blanket
- 1 Can opener
- 1 Laminated Kit List
- 1 Ready.gov Pamphlet
- 1 "Saving the Whole Family" AVMA Information Handout

First Aid Bag:

- 1 Zip-loc bag
- 1 Pet First Aid Label
- 2 Gauze Pads
- 1 Gauze Roll
- 1 Triple Antibiotic
- 2 Alcohol Preps.
- 1 Pair of Plastic Gloves

Identification Bag:

- 1 Zip-loc bag
- 1 Pet Identification Label
- 1 Pen
- 1 Notepad
- 1 Identification Tag (Green Plastic Tag, White Information Label, Spring Ring)
- 1 Disposable Write-on Collar

Cats Only:

- 1 Gallon Freezer Bag
- Cat Litter
- 1 Litter Pan
- 1 Litter Scoop

Instructions:

- 1) Put items in pail as you gather them.
- 2) Place “front” and “back” labels on the pail. Place “Cat Kit” or “Dog Kit” label on lid (see demo).
- 3) Roll 6 “Waste bags” tightly and secure with Rubber band.
- 4) First Aid Bag: place “First Aid” label on Zip-loc bag and fill bag with the supplies listed under “First Aid” on Page 1.
- 5) Identification Bag: place “Identification & Photos” label on Zip-loc bag and fill bag with the items listed under “Identification Bag” on Page 1.
- 6) Cat Kit: using “1 Gallon Freezer Bag” - fill two-thirds of the bag with “Cat Litter” and seal.
- 7) Place towel or blanket in the bottom of the pail.
- 8) Fill pail with remainder of the supplies from the list (make sure cat supplies only go in cat kits).
- 9) Put handouts and information sheets on top of the supplies (so that this is the first seen when kit is opened).
- 10) Place lid on pail.
